



INTERNATIONAL ENTRY INSTRUCTIONS

1. You must fill out a US customs form and pay all applicable fees and taxes IN ADDITION to your entry fees.

Please use:

TTB Import Permit Number is: CA-I-15358

FDA number is: 15259221836

2. You must label your bottles and your shipments

TEMPORARY LABELS

Must be attached to each wine bottle

Must be on the outside of each box you ship.

Temporary labels with the Government Warning PDF attached

3. You must copy, fill out and email a word document or PDF back to info@prowinebuyerscomp.info the cola_waiverrequest (see below, page 11). We will sign and fax the completed document to the US TTB (agency responsible for alcohol). The cola waiver is in case Customs, or a shipper asks for it.

INTERNATIONAL SHIPPING & PAYMENT INSTRUCTIONS

PLEASE NOTE: These instructions apply ONLY if you are shipping direct. U.S. Based importers and Distributors, please follow shipping instructions for U.S. Shipments.

WINE SHIPMENT

Wines may be shipped BY UPS OR FEDEX immediately to completely secure, climate-controlled storage facility. International Wines shipped from outside the U.S. MUST ARRIVE NO LATER THAN January 10 or they will not be judged.
